- (i.) *Conference Presentation Grant Program*
- a. Khalid, representative of SG Executive, & Judy Pollock, SG Services & Manager of CPGP, were present.
  - b. Funding has been cut due to cuts made across all SG funded entities.
  - c. GAU Representative asked about funding cuts for Graduate Student Organizations. Khalid states that Student Affairs has mandated cuts due to a change in the budgeting accounting process whereby instead of estimating how much money will be received, SG must now use actual funds that they have.
  - d. Khalid also stated the SG Exec branch budget was increased solely because Student Resource Agency was dissolved and now incorporated into SG Executive. Also SG wages were increased due to a need to allocate more for wages that what will actually be used. This requirement was mandated by Student Affairs on SG.
